International Dormitory Q&A (for students who will enroll at Kinugasa Campus)

Q	How many students does a room accommodate?	\vec{A}	All student rooms are single-occupancy. Bathrooms and shower rooms are shared.
Q	Can I enter the international dormitory in the middle of a semester?	\vec{A}	You cannot enter the dormitory in the middle of a semester. If you wish to enter the dormitory, please follow the procedures found in the guidebook that will be sent to you before you enter the university.
Q	Is there a cafeteria in the dormitory?	\vec{A}	No, there is no cafeteria. However, you can prepare meals using the shared kitchen.
Q	How much is the dormitory fee?	\vec{A}	The fee for the international dormitory has not been determined yet. However, it should be less than ¥50,000 per month.
Q	Is Internet access available?	\vec{A}	Wi-Fi is available. The usage fee is included in the dormitory fee.
Q	How long does it take to get to campus?	\vec{A}	It takes about 15 minutes to walk to Kinugasa Campus.
Q	Are there any grocery stores near the dormitory?	\vec{A}	There are some restaurants and supermarkets nearby. You will have no problem shopping for daily essentials.
Q	Is there a dormitory at Ritsumeikan University? Am I eligible to live there?	\vec{A}	Yes, there is a dormitory at KIC (Kinugasa Campus) for international students who will be studying there. Students who reside outside Japan at the time of application will have priority in securing rooms.
Q	Can Ritsumeikan University provide information on share rooms?	\vec{A}	No, we do not have any information about individual apartments or share rooms. Please ask the real estate agencies near campus.
Q	Do you have any information about homestays?	\vec{A}	No, we do not have any information about homestays.
